

II.2.1.9 Treatment with carbon

Classification:

- Oenological carbon: processing aid

Definition :

Addition of carbon to musts.

Objectives :

- To correct organoleptic characteristics of wine coming from musts affected by fungi such as grey rot or oidium;
- To eliminate possible contaminants;
- To correct the colour :
 - white musts derived from the white juice of red grapes,
 - very yellow musts derived from white grape varieties,
 - oxidized musts.

Prescriptions :

- The quantity of dry carbon used shall be less than 100 g/hl of must.
- The carbon added shall comply with the prescriptions of the *International Oenological Codex*.
