CARBON TREATMENT

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

HAVING CONSIDERED the work of the expert group "International Code on Oenological Practices,"

DECIDES:

BASED ON THE PROPOSAL BY Commission II "Oenology" to modify sheet 2.19 "Carbon Treatment" of the "International Code of Oenological Practices" as follows:

PART II

Chapter 2: Musts

2.19 Carbon treatment

The "definition» becomes:

- Addition of carbon to must.

Objectives:

- a. To correct organoleptic characteristics of wine coming from musts affected by fungi such as grey rot or oidium;
- b. To eliminate possible contaminants;
- c. To correct the colour :
 - white musts derived from the white juice of red grapes,
 - very yellow musts derived from white grape varieties,
 - oxidized musts.

In "Prescriptions", eliminate a).
